## WELCOME TO HELSINKI CUP 2020!

Helsinki Cup is one of the world's largest junior football tournaments. Helsinki Cup is attended by over 20,000 players annually throughout Finland and world – we are the highlight of the summer for many junior footballers.

In the summer of 2020, we are celebrating the 45th Helsinki Cup. Since 1976, the role of the tournament as a contributor to the well-being of children and young people and community has been preserved throughout the decades. Helsinki Cup is a tolerant, equal, international football tournament that respects all participants.

Helsinki Cup has gathered participants from about 20 countries in recent years. The number of participants in the tournament has been increasing for the last seven years. The percentage of girls' clubs has been growing steadily and over 200 of the 1400 teams in the tournament are girls' teams.

We work closely with the City of Helsinki, which means that the Helsinki Cup is always played on high-quality and well-kept pitches. The tournament has around 15 pitch areas around the city. Public transport from Helsinki city center guarantees a quick and easy access to the venues.

Football has, and will always be, at the core of our tournament. As the tournament has grown, we have invested in match-experiences while also putting a lot of effort in to various events so that now we can talk about a real Helsinki Cup experience. In addition to the games, the tournament week includes the opening day parade, the Helsinki Cup Summer Party and the events at the Love the Ball Center. And I haven't even mentioned the program designed for traveling support.

During the tournament week Helsinki Cup is visible and heard around the city. In addition to players, a large number of coaches, managers, mothers and fathers, as well as other supporting groups, will arrive in Helsinki. - Teams will only play against other teams of the same level
- After the group stage, the teams will be divided into A and B cup stages
- B cup stage will be played up to the final match
- The four best teams from final stage A will be awarded medals
- The winners of the cup final B will be awarded a trophy
- Only Elite -evel final will be played on saturday
- Team entry fee 340 €

The level should be selected during registration, and it can be changed until 15 April 2020. The tournament organizer reserves the right to change a team's level as well to combine levels as one series if considered necessary.

- After the group stage, the teams will be divided into A, B and C finals groups
- All of the finals groups will be played up to the final match
- The four best teams from finals group A will be awarded medals
- The winners of the A and B finals groups will be awarded a trophy
- Winner of C final will be awarded a trophy plate
- Team entry fee 375 €

#### AGE GROUPS ENTRY-LEVEL SERIES B10H-B17H

- All Entry-level series are played 8v8, also B14, B15 and B17
- Teams will be placed in groups of five or six for the group stage of the tournament
- After the group phase, teams will play a match on Thursday against a team that finished in the same position in a different group
- No other finals are played
- Team entry fee 375 €

The level should be selected during registration, and it can be changed until 15 April 2020. The tournament organizer reserves the right to change a team's level if considered necessary.

## REGISTRATION

- The registration period is from 15 September 2019 to 15 April 2020.

### RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE & OVER AGE PLAYERS

- · Participating teams must belong to an association operating under FIFA
- School teams will be accepted from countries where school football is favoured
- Finnish teams must be registered in Finnish Football Association. The participating club must have teams that compete in FFA junior leagues.
- In the tournament, the applicable age limits of the Finnish Football Association and districts apply. Teams can make a request to the tournament organizer for an exceptional permission for over-aged players for the duration of the tournament.
- $\cdot$  The number of individual players on a team is not limited during the tournament.





## **INSURANCE**

Helsinki Cup does not have insurance for players, team staff members or other people who are taking part in the tournament. International players and team staff members must have a validtravel insurance or other insurance that will cover any possible accidents that may occur during the matches and tournament in general.

### **PLAYING FIELDS**

All Helsinki Cup matches will take place on high quality natural grass and (artificial) turf fields that are in excellent condition and specifically designed for football use.

## **HELSINKI CUP GUIDES**


Helsinki Cup guide services are available for teams that have booked the tournament package for the whole tournament week from arrival to departure.

- The guides will pick the you up from the airport/harbor and bring you to your accommodation
- The guides will assist you with getting from accommodation to the playing fields and they will also help with any questions that you might have regarding the tournament or Helsinki
- The guides will be located at the hotels and schools from where they will assist you
- $\cdot\,$  The guides are the link between the participating teams and the Helsinki Cuporganization
- The guides will serve teams in English or possibly even in their native language

## TRANSPORTATION DURING THE TOURNAMENT

A Helsinki Region Transport (HRT) travel card is included in the Helsinki Cup tournament package. Teams can use the card for free transportation during the tournament week.

- The card grants the carrier unrestricted use of public transport in the Helsinki area during the whole tournament week. This includes the local trams, buses, trains, metro and ferry to Unesco's World Heritage site Suomenlinna
- All playing fields of the tournament are located within a convenient distance by public transport
- Teams can also book transportation from Helsinki-Vantaa airport, the Helsinki harbors, the bus station and the railway station to the hotel from the Helsinki Cup sales team
- We recommend using the comprehensive public tranport system due to lack of parking spaces in the city

### **HOTEL ACCOMMODATION**

Helsinki Cup offers quality hotel accommodations through itspartners at Holiday Innand Scandic -hotels.

- All of the hotels are located close to downtown Helsinki and immediate vicinity of the playing fields
