WELCOME TO HELSINKI CUP 2021!

In summer 2021, we will be celebrating the 46th Helsinki Cup. Not even the state of emergency was able to stand in the way of one of the world's largest junior football tournaments, which shows what a popular summer highlight the Helsinki Cup tradition is for so many children and young people.

The tournament's role as a contributor to the well-being of children, young people and communities has been preserved throughout the decades since 1976. The Helsinki Cup is a diverse, equal, international football tournament that respects all participants.

In summer 2021, we are expecting more than 20,000 players and 1,400 teams to arrive from across Finland and all over the world to experience the joy of sport in a first-class setting. The tournament is highly international, with participants from around 20 countries taking part in recent years. There has also been a significant uptake in girls' football – in summer 2020, we passed the milestone of 200 girls' teams for the first time and we expect this number to increase.

We work closely with the City of Helsinki, which means that the Helsinki Cup is always played on high-quality and well-kept pitches. The tournament has roughly 15 pitch areas around the city. Public transport from Helsinki city centre guarantees quick and easy access to the venues.

Football has always been, and always will be, at the core of our tournament. As the tournament has grown, we have invested in match experiences while putting a lot of effort into supplementary events so that we can now talk about a real Helsinki Cup experience. In addition to the games, the tournament week includes the opening day parade, the Helsinki Cup Summer Party and events at the Love the Ball Center. And I haven't even mentioned the programme designed for accompanying supporters.

July's Helsinki Cup will be seen and heard around the city. In addition to the players, a large number of coaches, managers, mothers and fathers, as well as other supporting groups, will arrive in Helsinki. The Helsinki Cup is a communal urban event that spreads the message of joy and unity all over Helsinki.

AGE GROUPS G7-G9

- Teams will play six matches against teams of the same level
- No points or league tables will be counted, and a knock-out phase will not be played
- All players will be awarded a medal for participation
- Team entry fee: €335

AGE GROUPS G10-G18

- Teams will be placed in groups of five for the group stage of the tournament
- Teams will only play against other teams of the same level
- After the group stage, the teams will be divided into A and B cup stages and the cup stages A and B will be played up to the final match
- The four best teams from the final of cup stage A will be awarded medals and the winners of the B cup final will be awarded a trophy
- Only the Elite-level final will be played on Saturday
- Team entry fee: €350

The team level should be selected during registration, and it can be changed up until 30 April 2021. The tournament organiser reserves the right to change a team's level and to combine levels as one series if this is considered necessary.

AGE GROUPS B10 - B17

- Teams will be placed in groups of five or six for the group stage of the tournament
- After the group stage, the teams will be divided into A, B and C finals groups
- All the finals groups will play up to the final match
- The four best teams from finals group A will be awarded medals
- The winners of finals groups A and B will be awarded a trophy
- The winner of final C will be awarded a trophy plate
- Team entry fee: €385

AGE GROUPS ENTRY-LEVEL SERIES B10H-B17H

- All entry-level series and B14, B15 and B17 are played 8v8
- Teams will be placed in groups of five or six for the group stage of the tournament
- After the group phase, teams will play a match on Thursday against a team that finished in the same position in a different group
- No other finals are played
- Team entry fee: €385

The team level should be selected during registration, and it can be changed up until 30 April 2021. The tournament organiser reserves the right to change a team's level if this is considered necessary.

REGISTRATION

- You can register for the tournament at www.helsinkicup.fi
- The registration period is from 14 September 2020 to 30 April 2021

RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE & OVER-AGE PLAYERS

- Participating teams must belong to an association operating under FIFA.
- $\cdot\,$ School teams will be accepted from countries where school football is favoured.
- Finnish teams must be registered with the Finnish Football Association (FFA). The participating club must have teams that compete in FFA junior leagues.
- In the tournament, the FFA age limits apply. Teams can make a request to the tournament organiser for exceptional permission to include over-age players for the duration of the tournament.
- The number of individual players on a team is not limited during the tournament.





INSURANCE

The Helsinki Cup does not have insurance for players, team staff members or other people who are taking part in the tournament. International players and team staff members must have valid travel insurance or other insurance that will cover any accidents that may occur during the matches and the tournament in general.

PLAYING FIELDS

All Helsinki Cup matches will take place on high-quality natural grass and (artificial) turf fields that are in excellent condition and specifically designed for football use. * The fields are convenient to access by public transport.

HELSINKI CUP GUIDES


Helsinki Cup guide services are available for teams that have booked the tournament package for the whole tournament week from arrival to departure.

TRANSPORTATION DURING THE TOURNAMENT

- The card can be used for free travel during the tournament in the Helsinki area (and to some extent, Espoo and Vantaa), including the Suomenlinna ferry
- All tournament playing fields are located within a convenient distance by public transport
- Teams can also book transport to their hotel from Helsinki-Vantaa airport, the Helsinki harbours, the bus station and the railway station to the hotel by contacting the Helsinki Cup sales team
- We recommend using the comprehensive public transport system due to a lack of parking spaces in the city


HELSINKI CUP DISCO
